Technology Report

- Switch upgrade happened across the district back on February 20th and there was little to no issues with the switch over.
- Thank you to the maintenance department for replacing the batteries in the ups units in the high school server room downstairs. The switch back over to that power is happening the morning of the March 18th. During that time, there will also be two smaller battery backups installed upstairs in the wiring closet to help to keep network switches up and running in case of a power outage. The upstairs and downstairs equipment are all very vital for phone and internet service across the whole district. This will hopefully help with some issues till they can be fully addressed this summer.
- Chromebooks keep coming in with breaks. So far they are still under warranty so most of the damage has been being covered under the warranty yet.
- An update and refresh of the District network switches will be done on Monday the 20th. This is funded in most part by the E-rate program.
- We are looking into a few projects for this year's E-rate grant program. Replacing the outdated wireless network at VES is first, followed by an updated firewall and battery backups for the district. This is year 3 of the 5 year program for E-rate, and many think it will be much harder to get funded from now on compared to the first two years.
- We have been working on getting all of the State Reporting to match with Teacherease.
- We are looking at battery backups across the whole district in locations where our network distribution switches are located.
