### PHYSICAL EXAMINATION

- Must be completed for all new students to the district, within 45 days, of entering the district from out-of-state. Students transferring in from another Illinois school may use the physical they had at their last school, as long as it is current with Illinois requirements
- Must be completed for all students entering grades:
  - Pre-Kindergarten
  - Kindergarten (K)
  - Sixth Grade (6)
  - Ninth Grade (9)
  - New students entering from out of state
- Athletic physicals required annually if participating in any district sports

### DENTAL EXAMINATION

- Must be completed for all students entering grades:
  - Kindergarten (K)
  - Second Grade (2)
  - Sixth Grade (6)

### EYE EXAMINATION

- Must be completed for all students entering Kindergarten (K), or entering an Illinois school for the first time
- Must be completed by a licensed optometrist.

### IMMUNIZATIONS

- Immunization records must be up to date in accordance with current Illinois immunization requirements. Check with local Health Department or your physician for specific grade level requirements.
- Students in grades 6 through 12 must show proof of a Tdap (Tetanus and diphtheria toxoids and acellular pertussis vaccine – Boostrix or Adacel).
- Students in grades K through 12 must show proof of 2 doses of Rubella and Mumps or 2 MMR's (Measles/Mumps/rubella) – 1<sup>st</sup> dose must be on or after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday, and 2<sup>nd</sup> dose no less than 28 days after 1<sup>st</sup> dose.
- 2017/2018 School Year, students in grades K, 1, 2, 3, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 & 12 must show proof of 2 doses of Varicella. (1<sup>st</sup> dose on or after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday and 2<sup>nd</sup> dose no less than 28 days after 1st dose). OR provide written proof from physician or local Health Dept. of prior Varicella Disease (Chicken Pox).
- New for 2017/2018 School Year, all 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> graders must show proof of 1 dose of Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine (MCV4/Menactra).
- New for 2017/2018 School Year, all 12<sup>th</sup> graders must show proof of 2 doses of Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine (MCV4/Menactra). The 1<sup>st</sup> dose received on or after their 11<sup>th</sup> birthday and the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose received on or after their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday, at least 8 weeks apart. If 1<sup>st</sup> dose is received at 16 years or older, only 1 dose is required.

### ADDITIONAL ITEMS REQUIRED

### CERTIFIED BIRTH CERTIFICATE

- Must be a certified copy from the county in which they were born. Hospital certificates are not acceptable.
